Once again, ASU Women & Philanthropy is inviting you, as the leader of your academic area, to submit no more than **two** proposals for its annual grant program. If you are involved in one of our more complex units, please contact the Women and Philanthropy team per the attached instructions to discuss your proposal submission allotment. The applications you advance should focus on a project that embodies the ASU Charter, reflects a funding priority from your area, and does not exceed a **\$50,000** request. The grant application is online again this year, however, the overview and instructions to apply for this grant is attached.

While the grant could be viewed as a modest level of funding, this is an incredible opportunity for you to present big ideas and unit priorities to an influential group of donors, led by standing co-chair Sybil Francis. This group of women and their families provides tens of millions of dollars annually to the university. Last year, the grant program funded five projects for a total of \$250,000 and over the past 22 years has provided over \$4.8 million in grants to 106 projects across ASU.

Your responsibility: (or your designee)

- Select a project that reflects one of your highest unit priorities. This project should have a specific outcome that could be accomplished with no more than \$50,000.
- Ideally, these projects should have already been identified as part of key fundraising areas.

- If selected to move forward, participate in the next steps in the selection process as outlined in the grant application.
