Last year alone, the program funded six impactful projects, totaling \$299,076, and over the past 23 years, it has awarded more than \$5.3 million in grants to 112 projects across ASU.

Your responsibility (or your designee):

- Select a project that reflects one of your highest unit priorities. This project should have a specific outcome that could be accomplished with no more than \$50,000.
- Ideally, these projects should have already been identified as part of key fundraising areas.

- If selected to move forward, you will be asked to participate in the next steps in the selection process as outlined in the grant application.
